

## **CSSOD COVID POLICY 2020**

As we enter the 2020-2021 dance season things will be a little different to ensure the health and safety of our dancers and staff. We will follow the guidelines set out by the Ontario Government.

### **CLASSROOM**

- There will be clearly marked areas for each dancer to social distance
- Masks are optional in class but must be worn in all other areas of the studio
- Students will keep their masks and water bottles in designated baskets in the classroom
- Class sizes may be limited

### **ENTRY TO BUILDING**

- Only 1 parent to drop off dancer. No waiting in lobby
- Pre-screening will take place before entering the building, including a temperature check
- Hand sanitizing stations must be used upon entering the building
- Hand sanitizer will be used again upon entering dance class
- In the event that someone contracts the virus we will follow procedures and guidelines set out by Public Health

### **STAFF & STUDENTS**

- Staff and students will not come to the studio if unwell or have been in contact with a suspected case of COVID-19
- Staff and students will wash and sanitize hands often
- Staff will supervise the safe arrival and dismissal of student
- Staff will sanitize common touch points between classes
- Numerous hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the building

### **PARENTS & STUDENTS**

- Adhere to the prescreening upon arrival
- Ensure arrival and pick up of dancers is on time
- Parents are asked to wait in their car during class as our lobby will not be available
- Do not park in the laneway to ensure a smooth traffic flow
- Do not send your child to class if unwell

In the event of a Government closure all classes will immediately move to an online format at their regular scheduled time. You will be notified of the ZOOM ID# at this time.
